Apparently he did not try to reform the government from the inside. 6. \_\_\_\_\_ Bacon rallied 600 people to his cause, including more than 80 Blacks. 7. \_\_\_\_\_ Bacon's Rebellion encouraged disloyalty to the colonial government and England. 8. \_\_\_\_Bacon was willing to stand up for people who were not rich, including former indentured servants and slaves. 9.
